Buses will now make 5 Marion County stops

Noblesville -- The Hamilton County Express bus is expanding its service area to include northern Marion County.

The bus service, which offers door-to-door service in Hamilton County on small buses that do not have fixed routes, will take passengers to and from five locations south of 96th Street: Castleton Square Mall, The Fashion Mall at Keystone at the Crossing, Nora Plaza, St. Vincent Hospital and Trader's Point shopping center.

Trips to and from the new stops likely will begin July 1, said Connie Sanders, president of Janus Developmental Services, which runs Hamilton County Express.

The organization decided to expand its services south because riders need to go to Marion County for personal needs and to connect with IndyGo bus routes, Sanders said.

Reservations are required to ride the bus and need to be made at least 24 hours in advance. To make a reservation, call (317) 773-2688 between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. weekdays.
